## Lego Club Policies

### Format of Club

The format of the meeting is that the first 15 minutes is spent sharing creations the Brick Artist made at home. There is no assignment or theme; there is no requirement to bring anything. It is just an opportunity for the Brick Artist to show off a bit and possibly inspire some Missions. What they bring is kept completely separate from the rest of the Club supplies.

The Mission takes up the bulk of the meeting. They use Club supplies, and the Mission is announced at each meeting. The creations are talked about and then broken down at the end of the meeting as part of clean up. There is no homework and no prep-work. Each meeting is self-contained. They work on the Mission for about 45 minutes. After a 15 minute share and clean up time, they are ready to go home.

### Leadership

Each child has an opportunity to be leader. The leader is responsible for announcing Missions. The Leader is also going to be given tips to help encourage others as they build if they get "blocked" and to help keep the kids on track.

### Other Information

All children are welcomed (gender and ages). However, children 5 and under will need to have adult accompaniment during Club time. Parents are welcomed to leave children 6 and up during Club time. Please be courteous to the host and pick children up promptly at end of Club Time.

Cost of Lego Club is \$2 per meeting or \$4 a month—only when paid the first week of the month. This money is set aside so Brick Artist can purchase Lego's. Children do not have to commit to every week of Club; however communication is always nice and if you plan to miss, please let the Advisor know.
