



TOUR GUIDELINES

Before the tour:

1. Wear your T shirts. This is for identity and safety and a must for all participants.
2. Arrive at the local tour site or meeting place for distance tours (or distance tour site if you travel alone) AT LEAST fifteen minutes before the tour time. That will give us the time we need to have everyone gathered, hand out any needed information, and remind kids of the behavior guidelines well in advance of our tour guide schedule.
3. Have the cell number of the KidsROCK tour coordinator to maintain optimum communication.

At the tour:

Parents and Kids need to listen to and follow the rules.

“Welcome to our tour. To help everyone get the most from our tour we have a few guidelines to follow. Please remember that we are representing Christians, homeschooling, and KidsROCK today. These policies are in effect until you depart from the KidsROCK group, and ideally until you remove your KidsROCK shirts.”

1. Stay close to an adult at all times, and be sure your parents know where you are.
2. Be sure your feet are walking and always on the floor.
3. Use your best inside voice when we are inside and speak respectfully to everyone, especially adults.
4. Keep your hands to yourself.
5. If you have a question or need something, ask a KidsROCK adult, or raise your hand and wait to be called on.
